



Congratulations to Corporate Fellow Dr. Ming-Jun Li on receiving the 2023 John Tyndall Award for his various innovations and contributions to advancements in optical fiber that have advanced the way the world works, learns, and lives.

The Tyndall Award is one of the top honors in the fiber optics community and was presented at the OFC conference last week. It recognizes an individual who has made pioneering, highly significant, or continuing technical or leadership contributions to fiber optic technology.


